

## Program Philosophy

Valley View Learning Center strives to provide educational opportunities for at-risk students. The center provides an alternative for students who have been unsuccessful in the conventional school setting. Policies and rules, educational objectives, staff and resources are designed to accommodate student needs and to provide a comprehensive education using nontraditional teaching methods, consistent with goals of the student, parent and their home school district.



## Diploma Program

### **Individualized Instruction:**

Teachers facilitate the learning opportunities for students. Continuous progress enables students to work at a self-defined pace.

**Secondary and Adult Students:** The program accepts secondary students who are eligible to enroll by the High School Graduation Incentives Law, Minnesota Open Enrollment Laws or their respective school district policies and regulations.

### **Required and Elective Classes:**

In addition to the traditional basic skills courses, students may participate in work or community based experiences for credit. Students may also enroll in a post-secondary institution through the Post-Secondary Options Law.

Diploma criteria is based on the resident school district. The center awards credit upon satisfactory completion of the work. A diploma is granted by the student's respective high school.

## Student Commitment

**Attendance:** Students must have regular and consistent attendance and successfully complete all work to earn credit in each class.

**Assignments:** Students work is self-paced. All work is to be completed in class.

### **Admissions Policy:**

Our program is open to eligible students through a variety of avenues. We prefer students meet with their home district principal or counselor to help expedite the process.
